Blues Workshop

Blues Workshop teaches the traditions, songs and musical elements that make the style so compelling. This workshop is meant to learn and jam on classic and contemporary Blues songs and share music together in a loose and fun loving environment. This workshop is open to guitars, vocals, keyboards, bass, drums.

Applying Harmony

This course is designed for anyone who has ever been stopped in their pursuit of music by a mysterious chord symbol or scale. The aim of this course is to use the major scale, the minor scale, and the chords derived from these systems to navigate the diverse music of the 20th and 21st century.

Improvisation Workshop

Come demystify the scales and chords that defined American music throughout the 20th century. Together we will examine the essential devices necessary to play a variety of styles and classic song forms in order to further our understanding of improvised music.

Rock Workshop

We teach many styles, but in the end most of us just want to rock. In the Rock Workshop students of all instruments will learn to perform a wide variety of classic and modern rock. Students will learn more than just the notes; they learn what it really means to ROCK!
